Frank Seney of Remington & Vernick Engineers (RVE) opened the PIC and discussed the purpose of the gathering. It was to present the project to the public in accordance with project federal funding requirements and to obtain comments, suggestions and answer questions raised at the meeting. The meeting was also being presented to the public virtually through TEAMS.

Tara McKay presented a power point presentation detailing the project including proposed improvements and an anticipated schedule for construction.

The following comments and questions were made at the meeting.

- Keith Lamb the Borough Public Works Director requested the County consider the asphalt paving to be completed at night to provide less disturbance to the commercial businesses along Kings Highway. RVE will discuss this option with the County.
- It was requested to verify the type of signs to be replaced. Signs being replaced are predominantly regulatory signs such as Stop Signs, Lane Designation Signs, County Route Numbers and Do Not Enter Signs.
- There are parades and events along Kings Highway that will impact the construction. These event dates shall be listed in the construction documents to exclude construction from occurring on and around these dates.
- Kingsway Transportation should be notified of the construction as they provide school bus transportation along Kings Highway.
- RVE shall provide Jenna Dolbow with the County link to the presentation and project information.
- It was requested for the County to review adding sidewalk at the post office where none presently exists. RVE verified that new sidewalk is proposed for this location.
- It was suggested to invite EMS to the project's pre-construction meeting
- Blue Raised Pavement Markers (RPM's) were requested to be installed across from all fire hydrants along Kings Highway. It was estimated there are approximately 14 fire hydrants within the project limits.
- It was requested to add a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) at the Post Office.
- It was requested to add pavement restriping to the project from the Roundabout to Shop Rite as it was beginning to fade.
- It was requested to add bicycle signage and/or shared lane bicycle markings.
- A Spanish version of the presentation was requested to be added to the County's website.
- There is no overnight parking along Kings Highway so parking will not impede the work if night paving was to occur.
- The section from the Firehouse to the Roundabout is predominantly residential and night paving was not encouraged in this section.
- Swedesboro Day is September 28, 2024 and no construction can occur on that day.
- There is a Christmas Parade at Thanksgiving so no construction can occur that day.
